I. DESIGN PROGRAM


Described within this design program is the project scope, schedule and budget along with associated considerations and review requirements. These statements shape the public engagement process, design and construction phases, and provide specific direction to the design team, project leads, and to those staff involved directly in planning, design and construction management. One intent of the design program is to assure that SPR's key players have a common understanding of the project before engaging the public.

II. PROJECT BACKGROUND - Dearborn Park is located in the Beacon Hill neighborhood of Seattle at the southwest corner of 30th Ave S and S Bandon St. Situated in the northeast corner of the 4.5acre park, and the play area was last renovated in 1997 and is need of accessibility and safety surfacing upgrades and equipment replacement, having reached the end of useful life.


A. PURPOSE

The focus of this project is to renovate the play area (approximately 3,000 sq. ft.) of the approximately 4.5 acre south section of Dearborn Park, to serve the neighboring community for the next 20 years, including meeting current safety standards, incorporating universal access and meeting the access requirements of the Americans with Disability Act (ADA). The major maintenance project is intended to replace play equipment, safety surfacing and upgrade the access pathways to meet accessibility standards.








