

JEFFERSON GOLF COURSE NETTING PROJECT UPDATE

INFORMATIONAL EVENT

Seattle Parks and Recreation is installing new netting on holes 11 and 12 at Jefferson Park Golf Course to reduce golf balls travelling out of the park. The plans for the new poles and netting system have been submitted to the Seattle Department of Construction and Inspections (SDCI). Permitting will require a height variance, which will take nine to twelve months for City Council approval. The new netting and poles will be installed at the edge of the fairways, along 24th Ave S. and S. Spokane St.

We anticipate starting construction in spring 2023 after the permit is approved.
