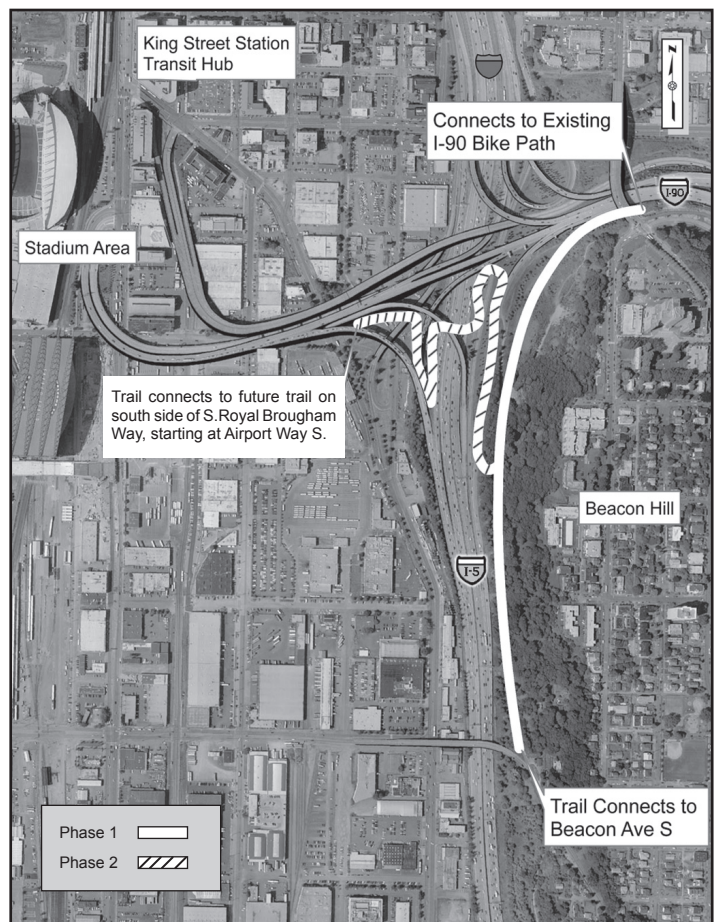
**TIME: 6:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M.

Seattle Department of Transportation staff will be present at the open house to explain the project and receive comments from those attending.

Project Description:

This project will design and construct a multi-use trail that extends south from the existing Mountains-to-Sound Trail ending at Jose Rizal Bridge, and move along the east side of I-5 in the North Beacon Hill neighborhood to the existing South Holgate Street Bridge to allow access across I-5 to Airport Way South (Phase 1).

SDOT is also considering extending construction of the trail west from the Phase 1 extension, along the south side of I-90 and possibly crossing I-5 to Airport Way South (Phase 2).



Schedule:

SDOT is looking to complete design in 2007 and 2008 with construction to occur in 2008 or 2009.
