# **Requesting a Code Amendment**

Updated April 19, 2007

Any citizen may initiate a request to amend the text of the codes and regulations administered by Seattle Department of Construction and Inspections (SDCI). which include the following:

NOTE: Sign regulations are located in both the Seattle Building Code and the Seattle Land Use Code. We generally review codes on a periodic basis for necessary updates and maintenance. A citizen request for a code amendment may be handled individually or may be incorporated into an upcoming routine review and update. There is no fee for submission or review of a code amendment request.

A request to change a code becomes law only after approval by the City Council and the Mayor. Decisions by elected officials occur after SDCI prepares a report and recommendation on a proposed change. The department is not obligated to prepare a report or propose code amendments on every request received.

To initiate an amendment request for any of the listed codes, fill out the form on page 2 and submit it to the appropriate SDCI unit:
