Shoreline Master Program Update

The Department of Planning and Development is revising our Shoreline Master Program (SMP). The SMP establishes land use policies to manage the recreational, economic, and ecological resources of Seattle's marine and freshwater shorelines. The goals of the SMP are to maintain water dependent uses along the waterfront, improve public access, and restore ecological functions.

Information on the new state guidelines for SMP updates, and our plan for public participation will be presented at the Open House. Public participation will continue through 2009, with new regulations anticipated in 2009-2010.
