


Distribution of Organizations by Size of Facility



How Many, How Big?

Above we see the distribution of cultural facilities by size. In Seattle, there are only four facilities over 250,000 square feet (which is gigantic, think Museum of Flight, or Downtown Central Library), while the vast majority of spaces, over 130 of them, are under 5,000 square feet. While it may be intuitive that the smaller the spaces get, the more of them there will be, it's still fun to see it borne out.
