**DISMISSAL ORDER**

The Executive Director of the City of Seattle, Civil Service Commission hereby enters the following:

**BACKGROUND**

By memo dated June 18, 2012, the Acting Superintendent of Seattle Parks & Recreation ("the Department") terminated the employment of John Jones (Appellant). On July 3, 2012, Appellant filed an appeal with the Civil Service Commission regarding the discipline taken by his employer.

Pursuant to SMC 4.04.250 (7), on July 10, 2012, the Commission delegated the appeal to the Office of the Hearing Examiner and the hearing took place on October 9 & 11, and November 16, 19 & 20, 2012. Appellant was represented by Preston Hampton and the Department was represented by Fritz Wollett, Assistant City Attorney.

On December 21, 2012, Anne Watanabe, Deputy Hearing Examiner, issued the Findings and Decision in this matter affirming the discipline imposed upon Appellant. Appellant filed a Petition for Review of the Presiding Officer's Decision on January 2, 2013. The Department filed its response on January 7, 2013.

At its January 16, 2013 monthly meeting the Commission reviewed the Findings and Decision of the Hearing Examiner and Appellant's Petition for Review and affirmed the decision to uphold the termination of Appellant's employment.

**ORDER**

The Civil Service Commission hereby dismisses this appeal with *prejudice*.
