**THE OFFICE OF WOMEN'S RIGHTS**

In Seattle, discrimination is illegal. The Seattle Office of Women's Rights (OWR) enforces City ordinances which prohibit discrimination on the basis of sex, marital status or sexual orientation.

These anti-discrimination laws are the Seattle Fair Employment Practices Ordinance 102262, as amended, and The Seattle Open Housing Ordinance 104389, as amended.

If you feel you have been discriminated against within the City of Seattle because of your SEX (female or male), MARITAL STATUS (single, married, divorced, separated, or widowed) or SEXUAL ORIENTATION (heterosexual, bisexual or homosexual) contact:
