

**CITY LIGHT LEGISLATIVE UPDATE** 2019 Legislative Session Mendy Droke | May 14, 2019

## CLEAN ENERGY BILL (E2SSB 5116)

- Requires all electric utilities to eliminate from electric rates all costs associated with delivering electricity generated from coal-fired power plants by December 31, 2025.
- Requires each electric utility to make all retail sales of electricity greenhouse gas neutral by January 1, 2030.
- Requires each electric utility to meet 100 percent of its retail electric load using non-emitting and renewable resources by January 1, 2045.
- Establishes an administrative penalty equal to \$100 for each MWh for noncompliance



## CLEAN ENERGY BILL (E2SSB 5116)

- The bill passed out of the Senate on March 1<sup>st</sup> 56-42
- The bill passed out of the House of Representatives April 11<sup>th</sup> 28-19
- The bill was signed by the Governor May 7<sup>th</sup>
- A rule-making process will follow to address some components of the bill







# ELECTRIFICATION OF TRANSPORTATION (SHB 1512)

- Provides clear legislative authority for all utilities, Public and Private, to be able to offer incentive programs and services in electrification of transportation for its customers and ratepayers
- For the IOU's, the bill clarifies electrification of transportation planning language to ensure utility sector-wide consistency



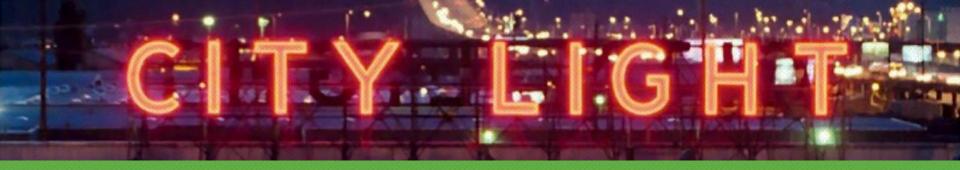
# ELECTRIFICATION OF TRANSPORTATION (SHB 1512)

- The bill passed out of the House of Representatives on March 21th 64-33
- The bill passed out of the Senate April 10<sup>th</sup> 36-11
- The bill was signed by the Governor April 23<sup>rd</sup>
- Requires City Light to develop a plan that will be adopted by the City Council
