



**THE SEATTLE OPEN HOUSING
ORDINANCE HAS EXPANDED**

On September 19, 2016, new legislation went into effect that expands fair housing protections for renters who use different sources of income other than wages and creates new requirements for landlords.

The Seattle Office for Civil Rights (SOCR) is responsible for administering and enforcing this ordinance. SOCR also provides technical assistance to rental housing providers.

- **New source of income protections effective September 19, 2016.**
- **Enforcement of the new 'First-in-Time' requirement begins July, 2017.**
