# NOTICE OF CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING ON A FOURTH EXTENSION OF AN EXISTING MORATORIUM ON THE FILING, ACCEPTANCE AND/OR APPROVAL OF PERMITS FOR DEVELOPMENT IN AREAS CURRENTLY DEVELOPED AS A MOBILE HOME PARK

On February 6, 2019, the City Council passed Ordinance 125764, which established (1) a temporary moratorium on accepting and/or approving permits for development on sites currently developed as mobile home parks and (2) a work program for considering permanent regulations related to redevelopment of current mobile home park sites. That moratorium was extended by Ordinances 126006, 126090, and 126241. The current moratorium will expire in July 2021.

The Council is considering a fourth six-month extension of the moratorium to allow the City more time to develop a proposal for permanent regulations to protect existing mobile home park residents and guide development of sites currently developed as mobile home parks.

The City Council will hold a public hearing to take comments on the bill extending the moratorium on Tuesday, June 1, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. The hearing will be held in the:
