1. BILL SUMMARY

- a. Legislation Title:** AN ORDINANCE relating to land use and zoning, amending Map A for Section 23.58B.050 of the Seattle Municipal Code (SMC); and amending the Official Land Use Map (Chapter 23.32 of the SMC) to make typographical corrections related to Exhibit A to Ordinance 125291 that rezoned certain land in Downtown, South Lake Union and adjacent IC zones.
- b. Summary and background of the Legislation:** This legislation makes a typographical correction related to Exhibit A to Ordinance 125291 that affects pages 100 and 108 of the Official Land Use Map, that erroneously labeled the DMR/C 125/75 zone as DMR/C 125/65 and corrects a technical mistake on Map A for Section 23.58B.050 to accurately reflect the change from the IC 85-160 to IC 85-175.
