1. Approval of agenda and minutes

The agenda and minutes for Wednesday July 16, 2014 and July 30, 2014 were approved.

2. Meeting with OPA Director

Pierce Murphy, the Director of the Office of Professional Accountability (OPA), attended the meeting to learn what OPARB had planned for the future. The members explained that they wanted to reengage with the city's citizenry and wished to work with OPA in order to achieve this.

The Board went onto explain that they had been working on project ideas for their Strategic Plan and what the goals for these projects were. Director Murphy viewed collaboration in achieving these goals would be a beneficial use of each other's time. How this would ultimately be shaped was a matter for further discussion.

Director Murphy went onto explain recent events involving OPA. Recently OPA changed the way they reported findings.
