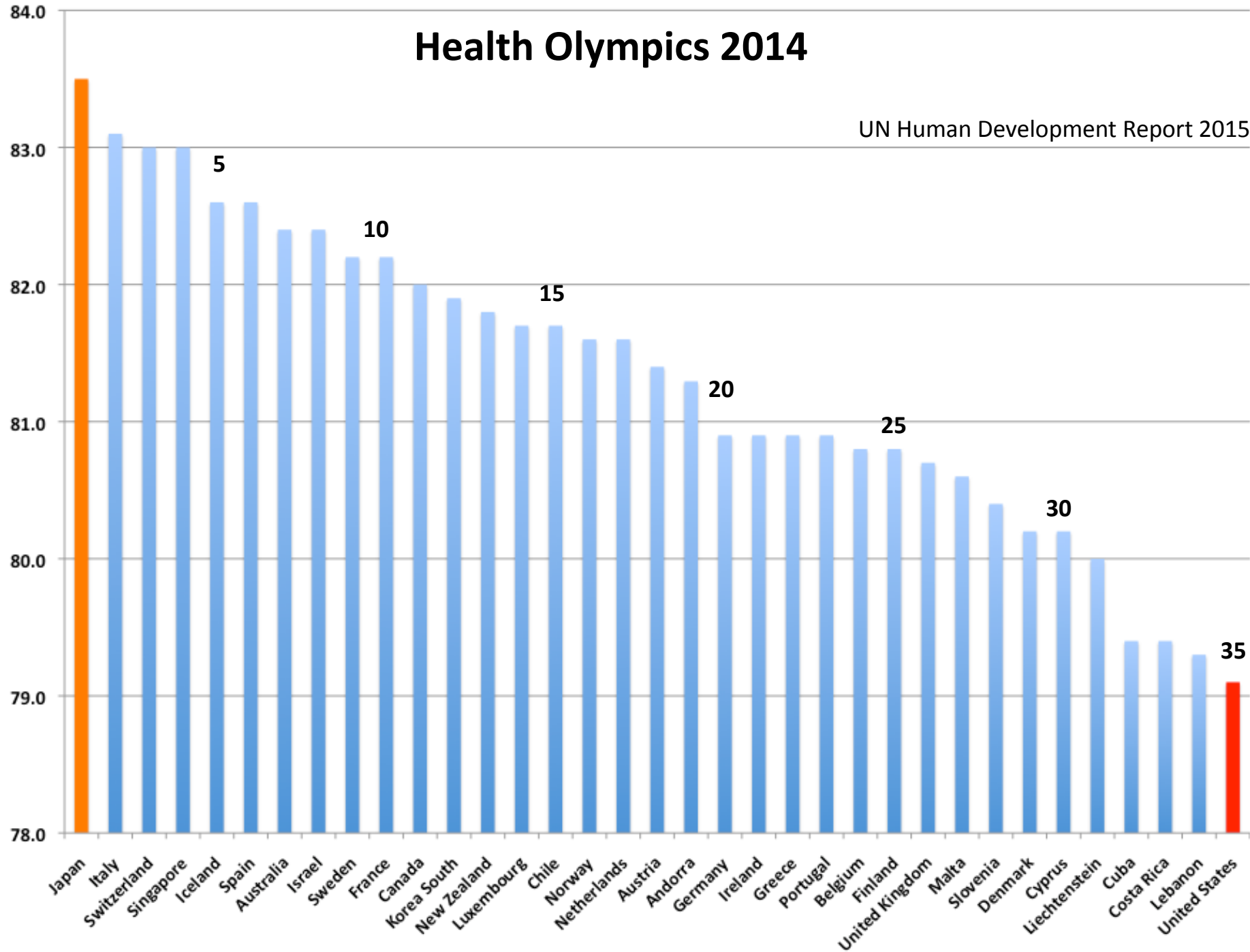

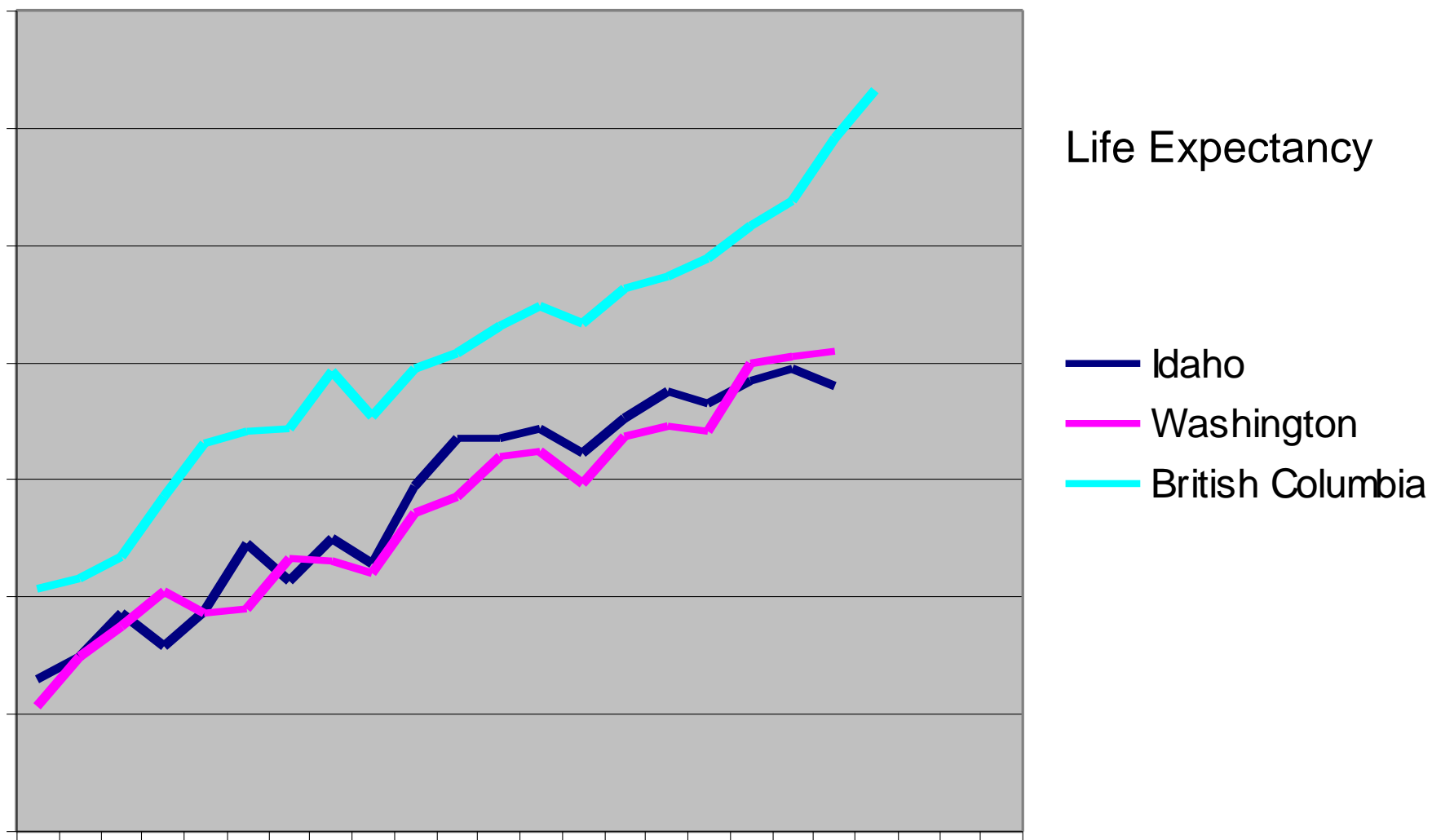

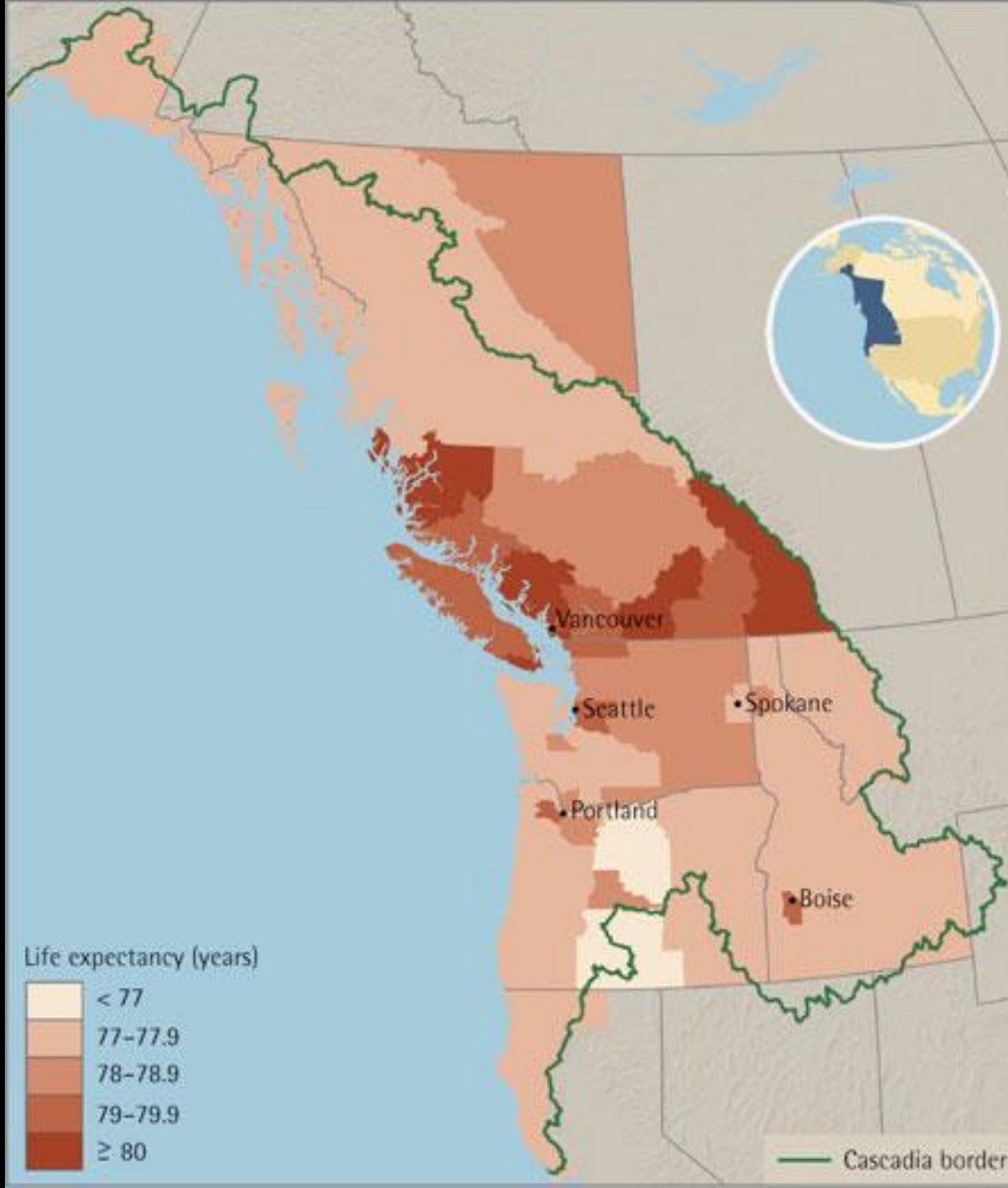

Life Expectancy (yrs)



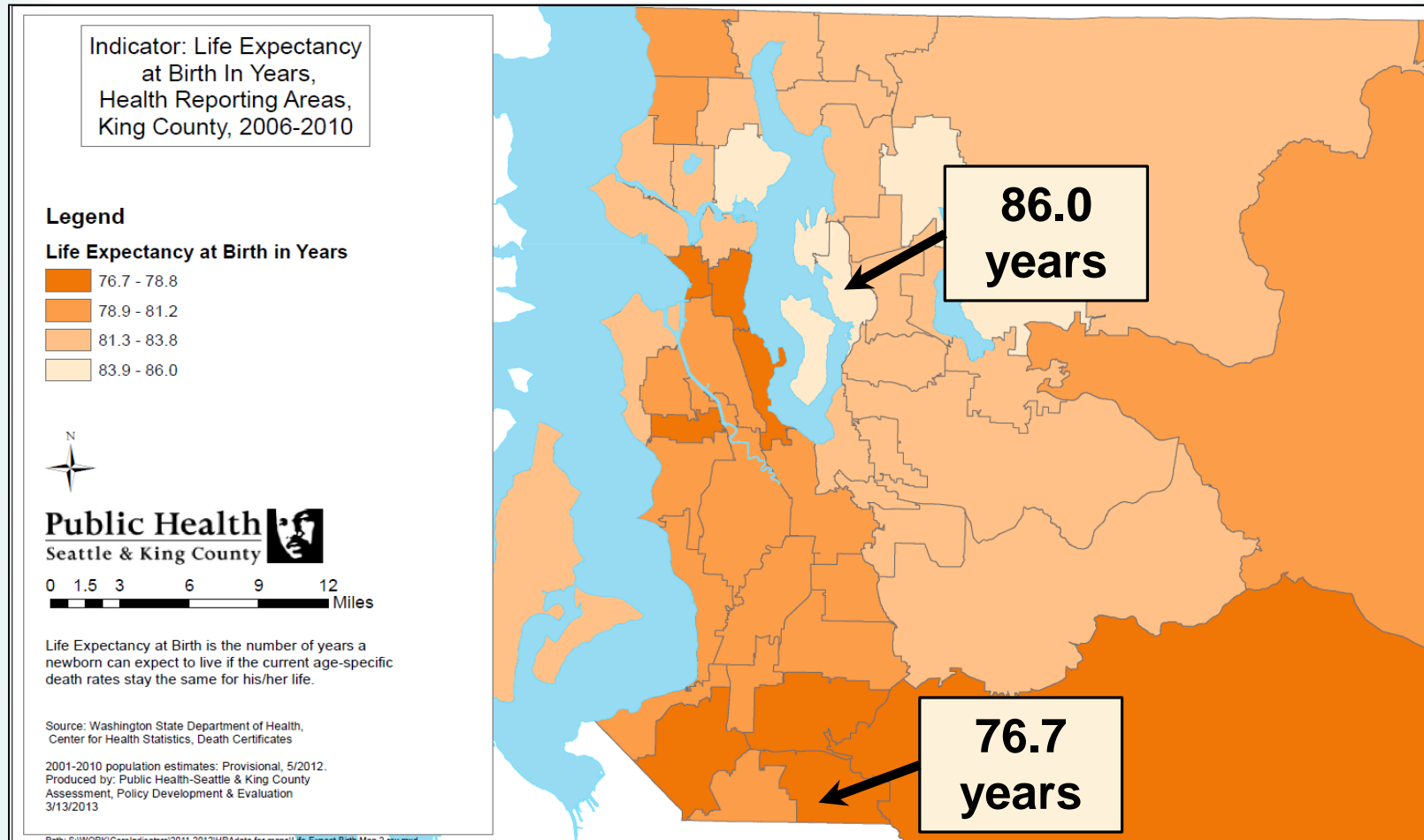

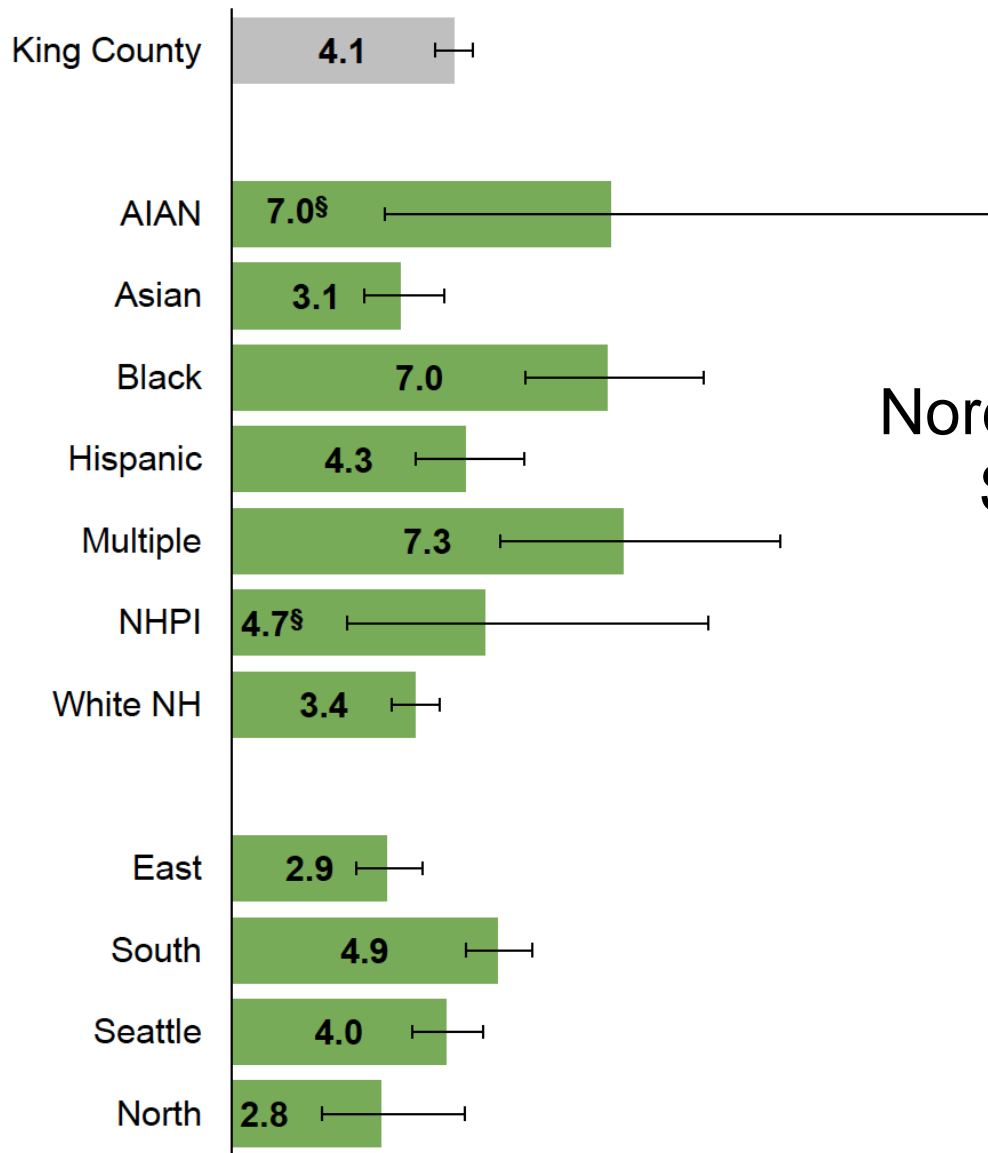

Infant mortality

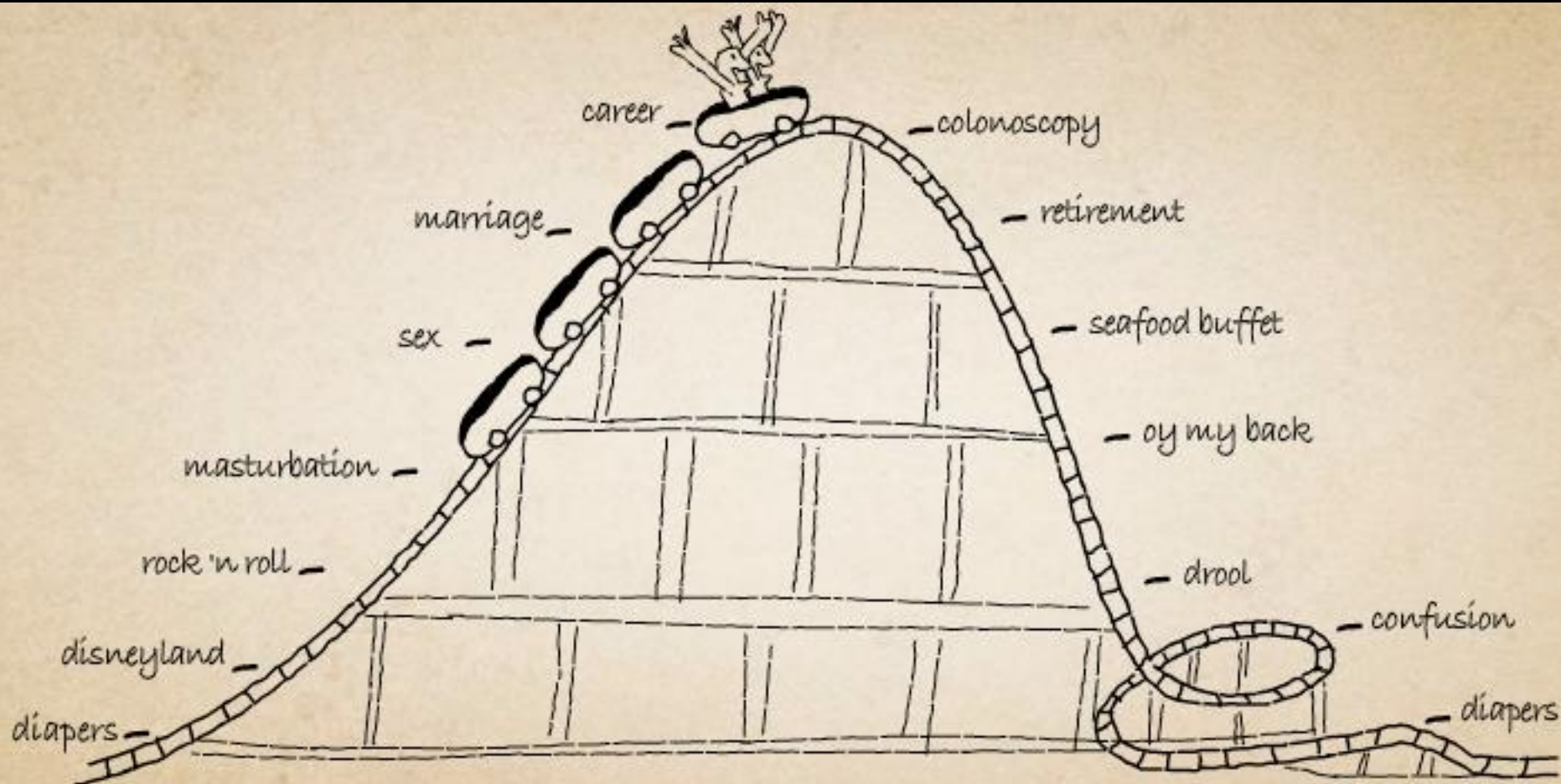
King County, 2008-2012 average

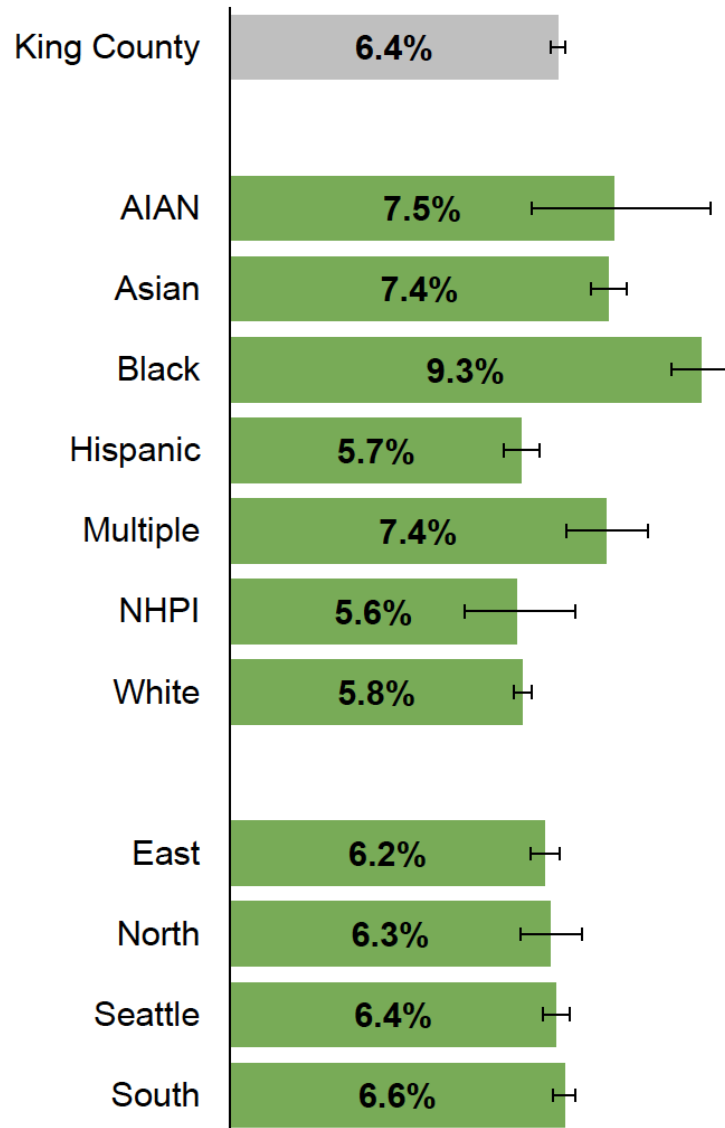


The First 1000 Days
