### Part & Full Day Pre-Kindergarten

Three-hour part-day, six-hour full day preschools are in numerous locations in Seattle. ECEAP is free. If you need child care beyond the preschool day, you may be eligible for DSHS Working Connections Childcare. You will need to pay part of the cost.

### Extended Day Pre-Kindergarten

Ten-hour day preschool available in some locations. You may be eligible for DSHS Working Connections Childcare. You will need to pay part of the cost.

The Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program (ECEAP), funded through the State of Washington's Department of Children, Youth and Families and the City of Seattle, offers part-day, full-day, and extended day high-quality, culturally and linguistically appropriate preschool services for eligible 3- and 4-year-olds and their families.

ECEAP also acknowledges that families are their child's first teacher and it is important that families have access to information and resources that help support their child's development.

### ECEAP provides:

- Nurturing staff who are well trained in how to foster each child's sense of security, confidence and readiness for kindergarten
- Developmentally and culturally appropriate classroom activities designed to support the social, emotional, physical and cognitive development of each child
- Health, nutrition and developmental screenings to support healthy growth and development
- Inclusive services for children with disabilities
- A safe and healthy environment for children
- Additional support for families including parent education and referrals for needed resources.
