**Levy Performance Measures**

- On time promotion to 10th grade
- Missing fewer than five days of school each semester
- Earning a C or better in all core courses
- Reducing opportunity gaps in core course performance

**Levy-Funded Key Strategies**

- Funding to support additional teacher time and class size reductions for students below grade level (three years or more)
- Partial funding for an Intervention Specialist providing case management and classroom based push-in support in designated classes
- Support for a school relations assistant to oversee all 9th grade case management, including identifying and monitoring struggling students who require academic assistance and support, or help regularly attending school. Case management services include goal setting activities, academic coaching, daily/weekly progress reports, and family outreach
- 9th grade Dean of Students works with staff to coordinate student interventions, uses data to monitor individual student progress, and conducts staff training
- Additional case management support for College Bound Scholars experiencing significant academic and social/emotional barriers
- School based health center services focus on treating and preventing health issues that interfere with academic achievement, including immunizations, chronic disease management, reproductive health care, oral health, and behavioral health counseling
- YMCA operates on-site summer learning program to provide additional academic and enrichment opportunities
