- Achieving growth targets on state and district assessments in reading
- Meeting grade-level standards on state assessments in math and reading

**Levy Goals**

All of Seattle's children will ...

- Enter kindergarten prepared to succeed
- Achieve academically and the achievement gap will be reduced
- Graduate from high school prepared for college or career

**Levy-Funded Key Strategies**

- Academic interventionists provide additional small group instruction for students struggling in reading and math during the school day
- Targeted after school tutoring sessions with certificated teachers for students performing below grade level
- Extended day programming for ELL students in need of additional instruction
- School wide implementation of social emotional learning framework to support positive relationships and emotional well-being
- Support for high needs families including home visits, connections to community resources, and parenting classes
- School-wide HOT (Here On Time) Attendance Campaign encourages daily attendance and recognizes attendance achievements
- Professional development for teachers focused on expanding instructional knowledge and capacity in mathematics
