In this all-new body of work, Seattle-area emerging artist **Vikram Madan** embraces a lifetime of creative influences: narrative folk and expressionist art Vikram encountered as a child growing up in India, contemporary American pop-surrealism, European classical painting traditions, his own self-taught background in cartooning and illustration, and a life-long love for poetry. The resulting multi-cultural exploration of the human condition is quirky, mysterious, whimsical, philosophical, and thought-provoking, often all of these at the same time.

Vikram Madan grew up in India, became an engineer, and spent many years in tech before following his heart into the arts. When not creating whimsical art in his studio, or public art around town, Vikram writes and illustrates humorous poetry. His debut book of funny poems, *'The Bubble Collector'* was nominated for the 2014 WA State Book Awards and has won a Moonbeam Award for Children's Poetry.
