#### Introductions

The January meeting minutes were reviewed and approved with no edits.

# Update on Work Progress, Reports and Safety

## **Work Progress**

Various scopes are underway, including setting the bones of the project with finalizing the structural steel work, interior framework, interior build out and the historic curtain wall scopes. Metal panel work also started this month. On the tunnel front, the next big milestone is getting the new service tunnel completed. There are 9 to 10 months anticipated to be left on the project and the target date for substantial completion is the fourth quarter of 2021.

#### Safety

There are no reportable injuries this month and there are no active COVID-19 cases being tracked. There are an estimated 800 workers on site.

#### Workforce Needs

There are currently no specific workforce needs. They are continuing to work with subcontractors around priority hire.

Performance continues to improve. Apprentice performance is trending upwards, and performance is trending well for women and people of color, particularly on the apprentice end.

### **Labor Compliance**

Two crafts had wage escalations; the roofers and electricians.

#### **Grievances**

There are no active grievances.

Jon Bersche discussed the legacy of Tyree Scott. And shared a success story of an ironworker named Emelia. She is working for Mortenson on the Arena project. She learned about the ironworkers through a friend, then connected with Tim Shaw and completed the ironworker's pre-apprenticeship. She is happy and enjoying her career.

#### **Pre-apprenticeship Updates**

Carpenters graduated a cohort of pile driver pre-apprentices that are available for work. They are currently running an interior systems pre-apprenticeship class. They are hosting interviews, via zoom, on February 18. They will host a general pre-apprenticeship class in March.

PACT is in week 6 of their pre-apprenticeship cohort, that will graduate in March. Mock interviews were last week. A graduate was recently indentured into the pipe trades and another graduate was indentured into the carpenters.

ANEW is on week 4 of their pre-apprenticeship class, and in week 2 of their PACE co-ed pre-apprenticeship class. Mock interviews for both cohorts will be held in February 16 and 25, respectively. The cohorts will graduate in late March and early April.
