ORDINANCE 108146

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Engineering Department; authorizing purchase of certain property for future street widening requirements, making a reimbursable appropriation from the Emergency Fund and declaring the emergency therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That as requested in C.F. 275465 the City Engineer is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to negotiate for and purchase for future street-widening requirements the following described property situate in Seattle, King County, Washington:

1. Lots 1, 2, 19, 20, 21, 22, Block 4, White Brothers Addition to West Seattle, less street.
2. The East 34 feet of the South 50 feet of Tract 18, Excelsior Acre Tracts.
3. Tract 1, Dunlap's Plat on Lake Washington, portion west of Rainier Place South, less the North 366 feet.
4. The East 8 feet of the South 35 feet of the North 1/2 of the West 143.75 feet of Lot 4, Block 5, Osner's Suburban Homes.
5. Lot 1, Block 9, Loyal Heights.
6. Lots, 6, 7 and 8, Block 68, Replat of the West Seattle Land & Improvement Company's Third Plat.

at a total consideration not to exceed One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200) including such administrative expenses and closing costs as the Engineering Department may incur in connection with such purchase, and for such purpose the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from the Emergency Fund to be reimbursed by the appropriation and transfer hereby made and authorized of a like

amount from the City Street Fund, and the City Comptroller is authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the necessary warrants and make the necessary transfers.


Section 2. WHEREAS, the appropriation herein made is to meet actual necessary expenditures of the City for which no appropriation has been made due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the 1973 Budget; Now, Therefore, in accordance with RCW 35.32A.060, by reason of the facts above stated and the emergency which is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon the approval or signing of the same by the Mayor or passage over his veto, as provided by the Charter of the City.

PASSED by three-fourths vote of all the members of the City Council the 7th day of May, 1973, and signed by me in open session in authentication of its passage this 7th day of May, 1973.


