ORDINANCE NO. 66616

AN ORDINANCE appropriating money from the Emergency Fund for the purchase of certain property in the Plat of Lake Dell Addition, and declaring the emergency making necessary such appropriation.

WHEREAS, in order to construct the sewer on 45th Avenue South, between Trenton Street and Cloverdale Street, as contemplated by Ordinance No. 66507, it will be necessary to secure a right-of-way across a portion of Tract 8, Plat of Lake Dell Addition, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the sum of One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00) be and the same is hereby appropriated from the Emergency Fund for the purpose of acquiring title to the South 60 feet of the North 172 feet of the West 51 feet of the East 151 feet of Tract 8, in the Plat of Lake Dell Addition, and that the City Engineer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate for the purchase of said tract.

Section 2. That the amount appropriated in Section 1 shall be considered a loan to Local Improvement Fund District No. 5388, for the improvement of Trenton Street et al, by Sewers, and said amount shall be included in the assessment to be levied for said improvement and shall be repaid to the Emergency Fund from the proceeds of the collection of said assessment or the issuance of the local improvement bonds of said district.

Section 3. WHEREAS, the above appropriation is to meet actual necessary expenditures of the City Engineer's Department for which no appropriation has been made, due to causes which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the 1936 Budget, NOW, THEREFORE,

Section 4. In accordance with the provisions of Rem. Rev. Stat. Section 9000-19, by reason of the facts set forth in this ordinance and the emergency which is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon approval or signing of the same by the Mayor, or the passage of the same over his veto, as provided by the Charter of the City.
