AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE PROVISIONS OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI, RELATIVE TO THE REGULATION OF THE BUSINESS OF THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI, BY PROVIDING THAT THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI, SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO TAKE POSSESSION OF ANY AND ALL STREETS, ALLEYS, AND PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI, FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF ANY PUBLIC WORKS, AND THAT THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI, SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO TAKE POSSESSION OF ANY AND ALL STREETS, ALLEYS, AND PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY OF ST. ORDINANCE NO. 85958

AN ORDINANCE relating to the acquisition of property by condemnation for the widening of Empire Way and Empire Way South as contemplated by Ordinance No. 84354; and amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 84463, by increasing the appropriation therein provided.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 84463, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE relating to the acquisition of property by condemnation for the widening of Empire Way and Empire Way South as contemplated by Ordinance No. 84354; authorizing expenditures by the Engineering and Law departments in connection therewith; and making an appropriation from the City Street Fund therefor,"

approved September 27, 1955, be and the same is hereby amended by increasing the appropriation therein from \$15,000.00 to \$20,000.00 to read as follows:

Section 1. That expenditures by the Engineering and Law Departments not to exceed Twenty Thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$20,000.00) in connection with the acquisition of property by condemnation for the widening of Empire Way and Empire Way South, as contemplated by Ordinance No. 84354, approved August 16, 1955, are hereby authorized; said sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated from the City Street Fund; and the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to draw and the City Treasurer to honor and pay the necessary warrants therefor upon approval in writing by the Corporation Counsel or the City Engineer of the various items thereof.

The attached Council Bill proposes the amendment of Ordinance No. 84463, which provides funds for the expenses of the Engineering and Law Departments incidental to the Extension and Widening of Empire Way between Dearborn Street and East Cherry Street, as contemplated by Ordinance No. 84354, by increasing the appropriation from \$15,000.00 to \$20,000.00.
