ORDINANCE NO. 81721

AN ORDINANCE accepting a deed from A. A. Tremper as Treasurer of King County, for a portion of Block 22, Gamma Poncin's Addition, for general municipal purposes, and placing the property under the jurisdiction of the City Engineer.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the deed executed by A. A. Tremper, as Treasurer of King County, on November 26, 1952, conveying to the City of Seattle the following described real property situate in King County, Washington, to-wit:

Lots 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6, Block 22, Gamma Poncin's Addition to the City of Seattle

be and the same is hereby accepted for general municipal purposes.

Section 2. That the above-described property be and it is hereby placed under the jurisdiction of the City Engineer.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.

Gentlemen:

The attached Council Bill proposes the acceptance of a deed executed by A. A. Tremper, as Treasurer of King County, on November 26, 1952, conveying to the City of Seattle Lots 1, 2, 3, 5 and 6, Block 22, Gamma Poncin's Addition to the City of Seattle, for general municipal purposes, and provides for placing the property under the jurisdiction of the City Engineer.

A substantial portion of these lots will be required for the extension and widening of Empire Way, but pending the final determination of plans for this improvement at this point, it is believed desirable to accept them for general municipal purposes and reserve them under the jurisdiction of the City Engineer.

The City of Seattle has paid \$268.93 for this deed, and the further sum of \$646.52 to satisfy the unpaid assessments outstanding against the property, making a total of \$915.45 for these lots which are now free and clear in all respects.


