NOTICE OF PROPOSED ADMINISTRATIVE RULE AND OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

The director of the City of Seattle's Department of Finance and Administrative Services (FAS) and the director of King County's Department of Executive Services (DES), acting under the authority of Seattle Municipal Code chapter 3.02 and section 6.310.140 and King County Code chapter 2.98, section 6.64.021 and section 6.64.111.C, respectively, propose adopting a rule concerning the Wheelchair Accessible Services Fund (the Fund) and using the Fund to reimburse owners and drivers of wheelchair accessible vehicles for certain costs.

Seattle and King County intend to repeal Seattle rule CPU-07-2015 and King County rule FIN-10-3-PR.

PUBLIC HEARING AND COMMENT: FAS and DES have scheduled a public hearing on the proposed rule for 9:30-11:30 a.m. on Nov. 23, 2019. The public hearing will be held in the Multi-Purpose Room at the Rainier Beach Community Center, 8825 Rainier Ave S.

All interested persons are invited to attend and present data, views or comments regarding the proposed rule, either in writing or orally at the hearing. Anyone wishing to comment orally at the hearing will be asked to sign up on the day of the hearing. Depending on the number of people wishing to speak, oral comments may be limited to two (2) minutes or less per person. Groups are encouraged to appoint a spokesperson to present their comments.

The Rainier Beach Community Center and the Multi-Purpose Room are ADA accessible. The City of Seattle and King County encourage everyone to participate.
