#### STEVEN SODERBERGH'S NEW FILM SHOT WITH TECHNOLOGY FROM TWO SEATTLE STARTUPS

Seattle startups Moment, which makes mobilephone camera lenses, and FiLMiC, which has developed an app to bring high-end video capability to smartphones, were used with an iPhone 7 Plus to shoot Steven Soderbergh's new film *Unsane*. Soderbergh told IndieWire he used an iPhone because of its impressive cinematography capabilities. "I think this is the future," he told the film-industry publication. "Anybody going to see this movie - who has no idea of the backstory to the production - will have no idea this was shot on the phone."
