In October 2019, Seattle Fire, together with Finance and Administrative Services (FAS) and the Mayor's Office, determined that the existing Fire Station 31 no longer met the needs of this growing sector of the City. The existing station has been demolished. A new permanent station will be built several blocks to the northeast of the previous Fire Station 31 location. View Replacement Station webpage link. The new interim station is providing the operational base for Fire Station 31 during the design and construction of the new station.

Two tent structures for the station's apparatus: Engine 31, Ladder 5, Medic 31 and Aid 31
