Fire Prevention Permit Services and Fees as of January 1, 2019

Permit Fee Increases

Permit fee increases of roughly 10-14% will take effect for permits issued or renewed in 2019. This increase is intended to better align fees with current service costs and to provide partial funding to replace outdated business systems in the Fire Prevention Division over the next five to six years. Fire prevention permit fees were last increased on January 1, 2017.

Changes to Permits Used at Construction Sites

In order to create better permitting options for use at construction sites, SFD is introducing two new permit codes, effective January 1, 2019.

- Permit code 1074 is introduced for **Temporary Storage and Use of flammable and combustible fuels (Classes I, II, and III) at construction sites**, which is valid for up to six months.
- Permit code 8202-Construction is introduced for **Temporary Storage and Use of LPG at construction sites**, which is valid for up to six months.
- Permit code 8202-CH is being eliminated and the hazard covered is now part of the new 8202-Construction permit.

All other permit titles from special hazards, special events, and annually assembly occupancy permits remain the same as in 2018.
