ZERO TOLERANCE RULES:

1. NO ALCOHOL or CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ON SITE WITHOUT A PRESCRIPTION.
2. NO VIOLENT, AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR, INTOXICATION, INAPPROPRIATE LANGUAGE – racist, sexist, homophobic, abusive – ON SITE or SURROUNDING NEIGHBORHOOD.
3. NO WEAPONS, INCLUDING KNIVES OVER 3.5 INCHES.
4. NO SMOKING, FLAMES, CANDLES, HEATERS, STERNO, ETC. INSIDE STRUCTURES OR TENTS.
5. NO SEX OFFENDERS ON SITE.
6. DO NOT ASK HOST OR VISITORS FOR PERSONAL STUFF. DO NOT ASK HOST TO CHANGE RULES OR PROCEDURES, OR GET INVOLVED IN CAMP BUSINESS.

7. NO STEALING OR THEFT OF PERSONAL, CAMP (NICKELSVILLE), or DONATED PROPERTY.
8. NO ENTERING PERSONAL STRUCTURES or TENTS WITHOUT PERMISSION (must be logged & noted with security.)

OTHERCAMP RULES:

1. Mandatory weekly camp meeting: (Thursday @ 6 P.M.)

NOTE: 3-DAY BAR IF YOU MISS THIS MEETING WITHOUT VERIFICATION!

2. Adult participants must do security work. (# of shifts determined by # of camp residents & H.O.S.) **"There Must be someone on shift 24 hrs/day!"**

NOTE: 3-DAY BAR FOR MISSING YOUR SHIFT!

3. Adult residents must have 1 participation credit (PC) by the end of the month.

NOTE: 7-DAY BAR FOR NO (PC) OR NO (NC).

4. Residents must sign-in themselves at camp every day. 3 days w/o signing in is considered a voluntary move. Your spot will be given to the next in line unless you were hospitalized, incarcerated, or, prior arrangements were made with approval. ***Your belongings will be bagged and kept for you for at least 3 more days so you can pick them up.***
5. Quiet time is 9 p.m. to 8 a.m. (Su – Thu) & 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. (Fri – Sat) NO LOUD MUSIC, TALKING, ETC.
6. Smoke only in designated areas.
7. Do not be pushy with donors. While at Nickelsville or on Nickelsville business, accept donations only for camp.
8. Only donation coordinator may give out donations.
9. Residents must be fully clothed outside their structure or tent (NO UNDERWEAR or UNDER GARMENTS).

MORE CAMP RULES:

1. Residents & guest must use the main gate for entry and exit.
2. Be courteous of our Nickelsville neighbors.
3. No jaywalking across Market St
4. No purchasing alcohol within 1 mile of Nickelsville.
5. Use the honey bucket restroom. (No exceptions!)
6. Do not meet barred campers within 6 blocks of Nickelsville.
7. All possessions must stay within your structure or tent footprint.

8. On shift security may immediately bar you for 24 hrs. for clear and compelling violations of these rules or disobeying commonsense and clear directions necessary for camp safety.
9. Nickelsville is eco-friendly. All recycling & trash and compostables/food are to be separated.

RULE VIOLATIONS:

(Permanent Bars/Zero Tolerance Violations):- You have 1 hour to leave. Your belongings will then be bagged and tagged. You will then have 3 days to pick up your belongings. After 3 days, Nickelsville will dispose of your belongings or any remaining items. **Failure to leave will result in calling the police!**

You can appeal your bar if it is not for violence, but first you must leave. Then call staff for instruction. However, you may lose your spot if space is limited.

“All other Rule Violations” – May result in a 24hr, 3-day, or 7-day bar. During this time you must remain at least 6 blocks from Nickelsville!

For non-permanent bars your belongings will not be “bagged and tagged” and you will not lose your spot. Other campers are not allowed to touch, bag, or remove belongings without the camper’s permission.

Your temporary bar may become permanent, if you come to camp before the bar is over. Exceptions include if your stuff is being stolen or meddled with in violation of camp policy, or if you want to give permission for your remaining belongings to be bagged and brought out to you, or other exceptions if H.O.S. or staff person approves. There is no penalty for peacefully coming to pick up your stuff.

Service, Case Management and Data Collection: LIHI is providing Case Managers to Nickelsville. The LIHI Case Manager will do HMIS surveying and data entry – in an informed-consent fashion – with all camp participants. Within seven days of intake into

the Nickelsville Ballard Neighborhood new camp participants will check in with the LHI Case Manager and complete the HMIS Informed Consent and Demographics forms. Case Management participation is not required. Camp leaders will share the names of exited campers on a weekly basis with LHI.
