

RENTAL HOUSING PROGRAM

City-Funded Affordable Housing, 1981-2016

For 35 years the Seattle Office of Housing has invested in rent- and income-restricted affordable housing.

The Rental Housing Program funds the development of affordable rental housing in Seattle using local funds such as the Seattle Housing Levy, federal funds, and other fund sources. Since 1981, the City has supported the development of over 13,000 affordable apartments in Seattle that will remain regulated for 50 years or more.
