The New Citizen Program (NCP) is a consortium of 14 community-based organizations that provide free naturalization assistance and support to low-income immigrants and refugees living in Seattle and King County.


NCP was created in response to the 1996 national welfare and immigration reform legislation limiting public benefits to non-US citizens.
