

Seattle's Paid Sick and Safe Time Law

PSST covers SAFE Time as well as Sick Time

SAFE Time provides Seattle workers with paid leave for absences for critical safety issues, including:

- Domestic violence;
- Sexual assault;
- Stalking



It also provides coverage when a place of business or school has been closed by order of a public official for health reasons.

Nationally, women lose 8 million days of paid work every year due to domestic violence.

In Seattle, workers can use accrued PSST hours to be paid for safe time absences.
