Use: Change of use from High stall (sale of fresh fruit and vegetables) to a business specializing in the sale of Washington state fruits and vegetables with Supplemental food items produced by independently owned Washington state farms.

Supplemental food items shall be less than fifty percent (50%) of the display area and include items such as eggs, dairy, packaged meats, value-add (i.e. jams, jellies, salsa, relishes etc.) native plants, edible and non-edible forest products. Five percent (5%) of supplemental display area for sale of simple serve products for off-site consumption limited to hot tea, prepared salad greens, cut fruits and vegetables and bottled beer/wine.

**Design:** Clean and restore existing features; install furnishings; install business sign.
