

2020 YVYC Funding Allocation

There is \$2 million of the Seattle City budget allocated to YVYC 2020. Of that, \$1.3 million is divided equally among City Council districts. The remaining funds are allocated to projects in Equity and Environment Initiative (EEI) Focus Areas. These are geographic areas where communities of color, immigrants, refugees, people with low incomes, Native peoples and limited-English proficiency individuals tend to live.
