Levy-Funded Key Strategies

- 9th Grade Academic Intervention Specialist manages a caseload of focus students, designs and implements project based learning in math and reading, provides training for 9th grade team teachers, coordinates with partner organizations, and coordinate data collection and analysis.
- Focus students receive additional math and reading instruction, designed to strengthen their core academic skills.
- University Tutors provide small group instruction, skill-building, and intervention activities aimed at focus students.
- YMCA Community and Family Partnership Manager manages a caseload of focus students, works to engage families, and helps smooth student transitions from 8th to 9th grade.
- Students explore career interests and post-secondary options.
- School based health center services focus on treating and preventing health issues that interfere with academic achievement, including immunizations, chronic disease management, reproductive health care, oral health, and behavioral health counseling.
