

Levy-Funded Key Strategies

- Math intervention classes provided to struggling students.
- Dedicated time for teachers to set collaborative goals, plan interventions, and monitor progress.
- Participating in Empower Mathematics Project (EMP) 2.0 Professional Development project in collaboration with the City of Seattle's Department of Education and Early Learning, Seattle Public Schools and the University of Washington. EMP 2.0 strives to improve teacher practice, support the integration of 21st Century Skills such as persistence and grit into classrooms, and engage families in the important role of middle school math in high school completion and college access.
