Levy-Funded Key Strategies

- Support Specialists from University Tutors and El Centro de la Raza serve as academic mentors and case managers, providing after school-tutoring, on-site monitoring and interventions for students struggling with attendance, and family training on academic expectations, support services, and student data.
- Intensified algebra offered to students requiring additional math support.
- 9th grade Academic Intervention Specialist works with teachers, manages community partners, and plans the academic mentoring program.
- Staff from North Seattle College provide College 101 supports for students and parents, with a focus on College Bound Scholars.
- School based health center services focus on treating and preventing health issues that interfere with academic achievement, including immunizations, chronic disease management, reproductive health care, oral health, and behavioral health counseling.
