### Levy-Funded Key Strategies

- High School Specialists develop a connection between school and students' lives beyond school, offering students experiences in the work world and helping them to set long-term goals.
- YouthCare case managers connect students to needed services and connect with students who are missing school or need additional support, including home visits.
- School based health center services focus on treating and preventing health issues that interfere with academic achievement, including immunizations, chronic disease management, reproductive health care, oral health, and behavioral health counseling.
