Levy Performance Measures


- Missing fewer than five days each semester

- Participating in Empower Mathematics Project (EMP) 2.0 Professional Development project in collaboration with the DEEL, Seattle Public Schools and the University of Washington. Empower Math 2.0 strives to improve teacher practice, support the integration of 21st Century Skills such as persistence and grit into classrooms, and engage families in the important role of middle school math in high school completion and college access.
- School based health center services focus on treating and preventing health issues that interfere with academic achievement, including immunizations, chronic disease management, reproductive health care, oral health, and behavioral health counseling.
