Levy-Funded Key Strategies

- Partnership with Odessa Brown to provide family-centered health, mental health, and health care access services
- Math and reading interventions provided to targeted students through a partnership between the YMCA and Madrona teaching staff
- Small group math and reading instruction provided by certificated Math and Reading Specialists
- One on one tutoring for targeted students to reach individual math and reading goals provided through partnership with Invest in Youth
- Collaborative partnership between Madrona Student Family Advocate, YMCA and Odessa Brown encourages daily attendance through a school-wide attendance campaign
- Schoolwide implementation of Social-Emotional Learning Curriculum as part of a comprehensive Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) system
- Student Family Advocate provides resources, guidance and referral services to help address basic needs such as housing, food, transportation, physical and mental health, employment, personal safety, legal services, and parent education
- Youth Services Associate provides students with positive behavioral support services social-emotional learning opportunities
- School based health center services focus on treating and preventing health issues that interfere with academic achievement, including immunizations, chronic disease management, reproductive health care, oral health, and behavioral health counseling.
