2. Workshops can be for teachers for clock hours, or for students/classes;
3. Workshops are total of 20 hours -typically over 3 or 4 days - cost is approx. \$2,500;
4. We offer three levels of workshops - Basic, Advanced and Training for Trainers; and encourage and advise Peace Clubs to continue;
5. We encourage students and teachers to become trainers in the program to give ownership to the community

- substantial reductions in school violence, bullying and classroom disruptions;
- greater community connection, less ostracation among students
- increased empathy and compassion
- increased positive conflict transformation skills
- creates a more positive and trauma informed culture in staff and students
