

## 2014-15 Distribution of Levy Funded Programs

### Levy Award Type

- Early Learning (22 sites)
- Elementary Schools (12 sites)
- Family Support (34 sites)
- High Schools (5 sites)
- Middle Schools (16 sites)
- Student Health (25 sites)
- Summer Learning (25 sites)

The Families and Education Levy mid-year results summary reports the percent of target students attending school regularly and passing core courses during the first semester of school year 2014-2015.

### Successes

- ✓ Step Ahead children attend school more than 90% of the time ( ↑4% from 2013-14)
- ✓ 11 of 12 Levy elementary schools met their attendance goals
- ✓ 5 of 5 Levy middle schools met their goal to have all **target** students passing core courses
- ✓ 4 of 4 Levy high schools met their attendance goals
- ✓ 5 of 5 Levy high schools met their goal to have all **target** students passing core courses

### Areas for Improvement

- ⚠ 4 of 6 Levy middle schools met their attendance goals

### Highlights

- ★ 100% of target students at the **Chinese Information Service Center** had fewer than 5 absences
- ★ Target students' attendance rates at **Bailey Gatzert Elementary School** improved by over 15%
- ★ Target students at **Aki Kurose Middle School** maintained their rate for passing core courses at 95%
- ★ Target students' attendance rate at **Madison Middle School** improved by over 14%
- ★ Target students' rate of passing core courses at **Broadview Thomson K-8** increased by 6%
- ★ Target students' attendance rates at **Cleveland High School** improved by over 6%
- ★ Target students' passage of core courses at **Cleveland High School** and **Ingraham High School** improved by 6%
