#### Number 1

The 2019 session began on Monday, January 14th. This is a long session, scheduled to go for 105 days, ending on April 28th. Leading up to session, hundreds of bills were prefiled. Combined with the bills introduced throughout the first week, over 700 bills have been introduced so far this session.

The House and Senate held their opening ceremonies on Monday. It was highlighted in the opening ceremonies that the 2019 legislature is the most diverse in state history, including having the first Native American woman (Rep. Debra Lekanoff) and the first refugee (Rep. MyLinh Thai) to serve in the Washington legislature. At the House opening ceremony, Representative Frank Chopp was elected as the House Speaker again for the 2019 session. On Tuesday, Governor Inslee gave the annual State of the State Address. In his address, Governor Inslee laid out his vision for the state and his legislative priorities for 2019. His proposed budget released in mid-December had signaled his top priorities, which include climate change, behavioral health, Southern Resident orca recovery, and education including investments in early learning and opportunities for students after they graduate from high school.

#### **Involuntary treatment procedures**

<u>SB 5181</u>

Concerning certain procedures upon initial detention under the involuntary treatment act.
Revises the involuntary treatment act. Prohibits the possession or control of a firearm by a person who has been detained at a facility for seventy-two-hour evaluation and treatment on the grounds that the person presents a likelihood of serious harm, but has not been subsequently committed for involuntary treatment.
Requires a designated crisis responder, before the discharge of the person who has been initially detained, to inform the person orally and in writing that: (1) He or she is prohibited from possessing or controlling a firearm for six months; (2) He or she must immediately surrender to the county sheriff or the chief of police of the municipality in which the person is domiciled, for the six-month period, any concealed pistol license and firearms that he or she possess or controls; and (3) After the suspension, his or her right to control or possess a firearm or concealed pistol license is automatically restored. Requires the department of licensing, in the case of a person whose right to possess a firearm has been suspended for six months, to forward notification of the restoration order to the licensing authority, and upon receipt of the notification, the licensing authority must immediately lift the suspension, restoring the license.

alternatives to the use of physical or deadly force so that de-escalation tactics and less lethal alternatives are part of the decision-making process leading up to the consideration of deadly force. Establishes a state policy that requires law enforcement personnel to provide or facilitate first aid that is rendered at the earliest safe opportunity to injured persons at a scene controlled by law enforcement. Requires an independent investigation to be completed to inform a determination of whether the use of deadly force met the good faith standard and satisfied other applicable laws and policies, except as required by federal consent decree, federal settlement agreement, or federal court order, where the use of deadly force by a peace officer results in death, substantial bodily harm, or great bodily harm. Requires a law enforcement agency to notify the governor's office of Indian affairs when a law enforcement officer's application of force results in the death of a person who is an enrolled member of a federally recognized Indian tribe. Requires the state to reimburse a peace officer, for all reasonable costs and expenses involved in his or her defense, if the officer is charged with a crime but found not guilty, or charges are dismissed by reason of justifiable homicide, use of deadly force, or self-defense.
