INCIDENT SYNOPSIS

A letter was received by OPA from an inmate stating that he had information about “law enforcement and/or military police undercover surveillance officers” who allegedly committed a “jewelry heist” in Seattle on a particular date.

COMPLAINT

The complainant alleged that unidentified undercover officers and military police participated in a jewelry robbery in Seattle.

INVESTIGATION

The OPA investigation included the following actions:

1. Review of the complaint letter
2. Investigation by SPD regarding possible robberies or burglaries of jewelry stores
3. Search for and review of all relevant records and other evidence

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

It was determined that no jewelry store robberies or burglaries took place in Seattle from a month prior to and a month after the date provided by the complainant.

FINDINGS

Named Employee #1

The evidence showed that no jewelry store robberies or burglaries took place; therefore a finding of **Not Sustained** (Unfounded) was issued for *Adherence to Law*. .
