INCIDENT SYNOPSIS

The Office of Professional Accountability received a complaint from an outside agency.

COMPLAINT

The complainant, the Office of Professional Accountability, alleged the Named Employee may have made Domestic Violence (DV) threats.

INVESTIGATION

The OPA investigation included the following actions:

- 1. Review of the complaint
- 2. Search for and review of all relevant records and other evidence
- 3. Review of external investigation documents
- 4. Interviews of SPD employees

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

The incident in question was an interaction between the Named Employee and his estranged wife, witnessed only by their young child. The ex-spouse of the Named Employee made allegations to local law enforcement that the Named Employee had threatened her during a heated exchange between the two of them. The Named Employee denied these allegations. Given the lack of any witness- other than their young child- to the exchange and the absence of any known video and/or audio recordings, there was insufficient evidence to either prove or disprove the allegation.

FINDINGS

Named Employee #1

Allegation #1

There was not a preponderance of the evidence either supporting or refuting the allegation. Therefore a finding of **Not Sustained** (Inconclusive) was issued for *Standards and Duties: Employees Must Adhere to Laws, City Policy and Department Policy.*
