**Question:** Why do you live here?

- near to relatives and friends
- convenient transportation i.e. bus routes 36, 42, 48 and 60
- close to Chinatown and Downtown Seattle.
- long history of habitation

**Question:** What would you like to see more of?

- low-income housing
- affordable housing
- 3-storey or lower house
- keep Red Apple and Beacon Market and want to see:
  - more Chinese supermarket, Dollar stores, pawn shop
  - a gathering place with shelter near the Link Light Rail station for exercise, cultural activities and music performance
  - farmer market
- Public Safety should go first before any development. Police Patrol should be more frequent in the Beacon Hill area.
- They would like to see more parks with playground, public restroom (charge or free), pool. They should be maintained regularly.
- Pedestrian sideway should be widened. Parking in Beacon Hill is difficult.

Comments on Link Light Rail as below:

- Stations are too far from each other
- Fares should be reasonable
- Free shuttle should be provided connecting seniors and disabled housing to the station.
