Section 2. For the initial building tune-up City-owned buildings shall adhere to the following compliance deadlines. Any exemptions for City-owned buildings under the Building Tune-Up Ordinance will be calculated based on these dates.

A. Buildings with non-residential uses of 200,000 square feet or larger shall comply by October 1, 2017.

B. Buildings with non-residential uses of at least 100,000 and less than 200,000 square feet shall comply by October 1, 2018. .

C. Buildings with non-residential uses of at least 50,000 and less than 100,000 square feet shall comply by October 1, 2020.

Section 3. The Office of Sustainability & Environment, in cooperation with the City's capital departments, is requested to establish a policy for asset preservation and equipment replacement that incorporates energy and water efficiency and greenhouse gas reductions as priorities, optimizes the opportunity for more cost-effect improvements when work is already being conducted on a building, and takes into consideration long-term life-cycle costs including ongoing utility expenses.
