5	WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 35.61.040, formation of the Seattle Park District became		
6	effective and its boundaries established as of August 19, 2014, upon certification of		
7	results of the August 5, 2014, election; and		
8	WHEREAS, the 2019 Adopted Park District Budget appropriated \$52,091,227 in total operating		
9	and capital funds, \$26,371,070 of which is appropriated to fund Park District operating		
10	initiatives (Resolution 25),		
11	WHEREAS, the 2019 Adopted Park District's operating and capital budget was subsequently		
12	increased by \$810,000 (Resolution 29); and		
13	WHEREAS interest earnings have accrued in the Park District fund through 2019, enabling one-		
14	time uses to pay for necessary expenses; and		
15	WHEREAS, the Seattle Parks and Recreation and the Seattle Park District have not fully		
16	appropriated all of the 2019 interest earnings that have accrued in the Park District fund		
17	beyond what was already appropriated in Resolution 25; and		
18	WHEREAS, additional funds from accrued interest earnings are needed to cover the Park		
19	District's share of Seattle Parks and Recreation's 2019 Annual Wage Inflation (AWI)		
20	cost; and		
21	WHEREAS, a budget neutral transfer within two Park District capital budget summary levels		
22	(BSLs) is proposed to enable a concept design for a new park on the Battery Street		
23	Tunnel Portal site; NOW, THEREFORE,
