

## Clean Cities Community Clean Teams Weekly Report

May 13, 2021

Reporting Week May 3 through May 9

### Week in Review

This week the community clean team focused on two large emphasis areas including Kinneer Park and Myrtle Edwards Park, besides the various litter and trash pick-up locations citywide. 27 additional Clean Cities sites were completed by the Parks/SDOT Clean Cities Teams and 14 additional sites were completed by SDOT crews alone. The following summary includes Clean Cities work accomplished by Parks/SDOT Clean Cities Crews.

#### **By the Numbers:**

- 748 needles collected
- 54,300 lbs. trash collected via Community Clean Teams
- 27 blocks of litter pickup by SDOT crews
- 5.1 miles of vegetation management
- 220 tents counted onsite
- 5 structures/signs of graffiti removed by SDOT

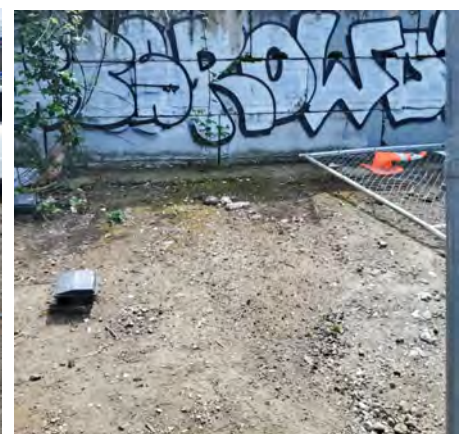


- Beacon Ave S at VA Hospital Vicinity: 18-tents, 12-Needles, 588lbs of debris -5/8

## Clean Cities Emphasis Areas

- Kinnear Park: 5/3, 5/4, 5/6. CW Crew weeded shrub beds, the retaining wall and line trimmed in preparation for mulching. Burlap bags were spread throughout the beds for weed suppression. Over 60 yards of mulch was delivered and dropped strategically along the beds. The crew spread the mulch and spruced up around a few tree rings. SDOT crew also performed 1 block of sidewalk cleaned, 2 miles of vegetation management and 3 blocks of mowing.

## Project cleanup
