Week in Review

This week the community clean team focused on two large emphasis areas including Dr. Blanche Lavizzo Park and Chinook Beach Park, as well as the various litter and trash pick-up locations citywide. There were 47 additional Clean Cities sites were completed by the Parks Clean Cities Teams and 16 additional sites were completed by SDOT crews. The following summary includes Clean Cities work accomplished by Parks/SDOT Clean Cities Crews.

By the Numbers:

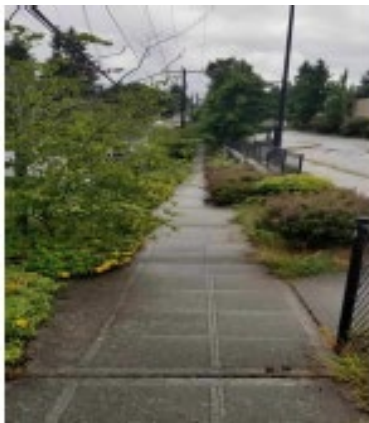
- 468 needles collected

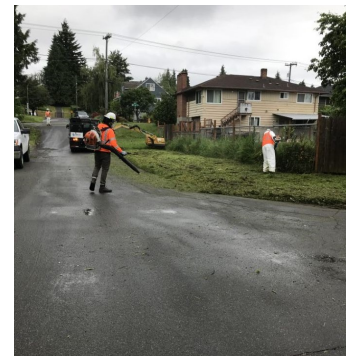

Clean Cities Emphasis Areas

- Dr. Blanche Lavizzo Park: 6/15. CE District hosted their jamboree at Dr. Blanche Lavizzo Park with staff from 7 Park districts supporting the project. The crews hedge trimmed overgrown vegetation, brush cutting blackberry thickets, line trimmed, performed shrub bed maintenance, and cleaned tree rings. The amphitheater stairs had weeds removed and blown along with the walkway.

- Chinook Beach Park: 6/17. Southeast District hosted a jamboree at Chinook Beach Park with staff from 7 Park districts supporting the project. There is a steep slope along most of the top edge along Rainier Ave So, some garbage and evidence of camping activity on the south end. The slope grade prevented staff from accessing portions of the park, however, the vegetation management work on the bottom hill side has been completed. This is considered a natural area and the Natural Area Crew (NAC) works on site periodically. The lower portion of this park has pebble rock beach access with opportunities for recreation. Parks crews cut down vegetation and lifted trees on the slope side so to expose the former fence posts and allowed the crews to remove debris.

Emphasis Cleans:

- NW: Across from 9519 3rd Ave NW
- NE: Ravenna & 15th AVE bridge (Cowen Park)
- SE: South Entrance to MNTS to Sound trail @ Holgate ST.
- SE: rose street triangle
- SE: Daejeon Park
- SE: North side of 12 St. Bridge

The Crews will be doing litter picks, trash mitigation; any bio- Hazard removal that may be required, and related grounds maintenance work. Crews will also be providing maintenance and cleaning efforts both in and around these parks. Field inspections and cleaning of right of way areas will include stairways, multi-use paths, streets, and sidewalks in the immediate vicinity of these parks.
