December 9, 2021

Reporting Week November 29 through December 5

Week in Review

This week the community clean team focused on two large emphasis areas, MLK JR Civil Rights Memorial Park and Northgate CC-Grounds as well as the various litter and trash pick-up locations citywide. The following summary includes Clean Cities work accomplished by Parks and SDOT Clean Cities Crews.

By the Numbers:

- Trash mitigation completed at 45 locations by Parks/SDOT crews, and 28 additional locations by SDOT crews
- 4,628 needles collected by Parks Crews
- 56,870 lbs. trash collected via Community Clean Teams
- 67 blocks of litter pickup by SDOT crews
- 414 tents counted onsite
- 7 signs of graffiti removed

Clean Cities Emphasis Areas

- MLK JR Civil Rights Memorial Park: 11/30. SC District removed blackberry from the shrub beds, lowered Oregon Grape (*Mahonia aquifolium*), raised up the Cedar tree limbs along the sidewalk for safe passage for CEPTED. The walkway along MLK JR Way was edged. Mulch was spread in the shrub beds for weed suppression.

- Northgate CC/Park: 12/2. NE District held their jamboree at Northgate CC/Park. The work consisted of replenishing and spreading engineered wood chips in the play area. Foliage and overgrown vegetation were cleared for CEPTED from the sidewalk back to the community center windows facing west. The sidewalks were edged and blown.
